Cookies

Cookies are a small amount of text stored on the user's computer, which is created by the website visited by the user.

The cookies used by this website are so-called session cookies and are used to record information from the session. These files are used for correct configuration of selected functions of the site, enabling in particular, verification of the authenticity of the browser session. The mechanism of session cookies does not allow the collection of any personal data or any confidential information from the user's device. Cookies are deleted when the session expires.

How to block and delete cookies?

The user may decide to reject or block cookies by changing the browser settings regarding cookies for this website or external suppliers' websites. More information can be found in the "Help" function of your browser. It should be noted that most browsers automatically allow cookies, so if you do not want to use cookies, you must delete or block them yourself.

Blocking cookies in the Mozilla Firefox browser

In the "Tools" menu, select "Options" and then the "Privacy" tab. The browser gives the option of disabling user tracking altogether or removing individual cookies from individual sites.

Blocking cookies in the Internet Explorer browser

In the "Tools" menu, select "Internet options" and then the "Privacy" tab.

With a special slider, you can adjust the overall level of privacy or use the "Website" button to manage the settings of individual websites.

Blocking cookies in the Opera browser

Press "Opera" in the upper left corner to open the menu and select "Settings" in it and then "Clear browsing history". In addition to the ability to delete already set cookies, there is also a button "Manage cookies" leading to more advanced options for individual sites.

Blocking cookies in the Chrome browser

In the hidden menu under three horizontal dashes, in the upper right corner of the browser, select "Tools" and then "Clear browsing data". In addition to the possibility of cleaning cookies, there is a link "More information", which leads to a detailed description of the privacy function of the browser.

Blocking cookies in the Safari browser

In the "Safari" menu, select "Preferences" and the "Privacy" tab in them. There are numerous options for cookies.

Blocking cookies on mobile phones, tablets and other mobile devices

Each phone model can handle this function in a different way. Therefore, we encourage you to read the privacy options in the documentation on the manufacturer's website for the mobile device.
